SUNY COBLESKILL **FIGHTING TIGER WEEKLY RECAP 10/8/18**

The SUNY Cobleskill men's golf team closed the fall portion of their schedule out in impressive fashion by winning the Sage College Gator Invitational on Tuesday at the par 72/7051 yard Albany Country Club. The Fighting Tigers posted a team total of 33-over par 321 to claim the title over the host Sage Gators. Then on Friday, Cobleskill posted a team total of 48-over-par 336 to place second overall in a field of five teams at the 2018 Lou Jarvis Memorial Invitational hosted by Northern Vermont University-Johnson State at the par 72/6908 yard Jay Peak Golf Club. The Fighting Tigers were led individually by senior Cody Latimer, Mayville, N.Y., Chautauqua Lake High School/Jamestown Community College, who tied for first at the Gator Invitational with a round of five-over par 77 and placed fourth overall at the Lou Jarvis Invitational with a score of 10-over-par 82 for the day.

The Fighting Tiger men's soccer team split a pair of home contests over the weekend losing on Saturday 2-0 to Lancaster Bible College in North Eastern Athletic Conference (NEAC) action then winning in non-league play by a 4-1 margin to Sage College on Sunday to move to 6-7 overall including a 3-2 record in NEAC action. Senior forward Patrick McGovern, Congleton, England, Congleton High School, scored a pair of second half goals on Sunday to lead the Orange & Black past Sage College and increase his season total to 12 to lead the NEAC.

The Cobleskill women's volleyball program dropped three-of-four decisions on the week losing at home to Southern Vermont College on Tuesday 3-0 by set scores of: 25-22, 25-11 and 25-18, then losing on the road at SUNY Delhi 3-2 by set scores of 21-25, 20-25, 25-19, 25-17 and 16-14 prior to splitting a pair of games at a NEAC crossover event on Saturday hosted by Penn College in Williamstown, Pa.: defeating Penn College 3-0 by scores of 25-20, 25-23 and 25-14 then losing 3-0 to Penn State Berks by scores of 25-11, 25-14 and 26-24 to move to 2-15 overall including a 1-5 record in NEAC play. Senior setter Mackenzie Holbert, Sauquoit, N.Y., New Hartford/Herkimer Community College, led the way to victory over Penn College on Saturday with a: nine assist, six service ace, six dig and two kill effort.

Freshman cross country runner Dillon VanDemortel, Newark, N.Y., Newark High School, has been named the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Division III Men's Cross Country Division III Runner-of-the-Month for September 2018 becoming the first Fighting Tiger cross country runner to earn the award in program history. During the month the Fighting Tiger rookie was named North Eastern Athletic Conference (NEAC) Male Runner-of-the-Week three times while winning three-of-four events.

The women's soccer team dropped three games during the week losing to Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts (MCLA) 6-1 on Wednesday in a game played at Oneonta State in Oneonta, N.Y. prior to dropping a pair of NEAC games at home over the weekend losing on Saturday to Lancaster Bible College 6-1 then falling to Morrisville State on Sunday by a 4-1 margin to move to 4-9 overall on the year with a 1-6 record in conference play. Junior forward Addy Lawson, Milford, N.Y., Milford High School, scored versus Morrisville State to give her nine goals and 20 points on the season.
